Less than half of U.S. companies offer health insurance to their employees (Kaiser Family Foundation)

43% of U.S. workers are contractors, and therefore not eligible for employer-provided healthcare benefits (International Labour Organization)

SOWHAT DID WE LEARN?

- Pandemic catalyzed the "consumerization" of healthcare
- A "telemedicine app" is not enough for consumers
- We must think more holistically and seek more connected experiences

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR YOU?

81% of respondents that offer telehealth to employees would also be open to offering a solution to part-time workers and contractors

75% of respondents who currently provide telehealth to workers believe that people are more open to using telemedicine due to the pandemic, and that it will be a standard part of medical care moving forward.

Lack of speed and long wait times are the biggest pain point with current telemedicine providers, with **41%** wanting faster access and shorter wait times

3 EXPERT TIPS FOR EVALUATING "TELEMEDICINE"

- 1. Compare apples to apples, especially for usage rates and pricing
- 2. Dig into wait times at peak usage times
- Understand who is providing care and their credentials

QUESTIONS TO ASK A TELEMEDICINE PROVIDER

- 1. Availability
- 2. Wait times
- 3. Ongoing engagement and usefulness
- 4. Features and services
- 5. Pricing and ROI
